Six Verses of healing from the Noble Qur'an

وَيَشْفِي صُدُورَ قَوْمٍ مُّؤْمِنِينَ

Wa-yashfi ṣudūra qawmin Mu'minīn

(Allah) heals the hearts of those who are believers. [Sūrah Tawbah, 9:14]

وَشِفَاءٌ لِّمَا فِي الصُّدُورِ

Wa-shifā'un li-mā fiṣ-ṣudūr

It (the Qur'an) is a remedy to what is in the hearts [Sūrah Yūnus, 10:57]

يَخْرُجُ مِنْ بُطُونِهَا شَرَابٌ مُّخْتَلِفٌ أَلْوَانُهُ فِيهِ شِفَاءٌ لِّلنَّاسِ

Yakhruju min buṭūnihā sharābun mukhtalifun alwānuhū fihī shifā'un lin-nās

A drink of various colours comes out of bellies (of bees); in it is a remedy for mankind [Sūrah Naḥl, 16:69]

وَنُنَزِّلُ مِنَ الْقُرْآنِ مَا هُوَ شِفَاءٌ وَرَحْمَةٌ لِّلْمُؤْمِنِينَ

Wa-nunazzilu minal-qur'āni mā huwa shifā'un wa-raḥmatun lil-mu-minīn

And We reveal in the Qur'an what is cure and mercy for the believers. [Sūrah Al-Isra 17:82]

وَإِذَا مَرِضْتُ فَهُوَ يَشْفِينِي

Wa-idhā mariḍtu fa-huwa yashfīnī

And when I am ill, He is the One Who cures me. [Sūrah Shu'arā, 26:80]

قُلْ هُوَ الَّذِي أَنْزَلَ هَدًى وَشِفَاءً

Qul huwa lil-ladhīna āmanū hudan wa-shifā

Say (the Qur'an is) guidance and a remedy for the believers [Sūrah Fuṣṣilat, 41:44]
